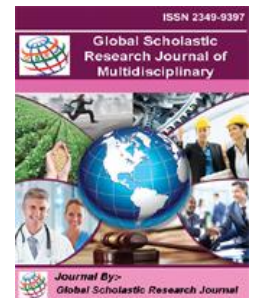

DETERMINANTS OF REMITTANCES FROM WEST AFRICAN MIGRANTS IN OECD

Abstract

This article addresses the issue of macroeconomic determinants of remittances from emigration WAEMU¹ in host countries. From this research, we show among other things that the remittances from migrants West African WAEMU space to their countries of origin, whatever the economic situation in the host country does not change the sending transfers of these. The variable inflation in the host country could negatively influence the remittances from Immigrants West African in OECD at a threshold of 3.6%. Moreover, the effective exchange rate contributes to the increase in the amounts of money transferred to the country of origin, since the volume of transfers is denominated in F.CFA, against the dollar and the euro.
